# ROTARY CLUB OF CHAPLEAU PIKE ICE FISHING DERBY CHAPLEAU RIVER, MULLIGAN'S BAY

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Participants will abide by all Ontario Fishing regulations. A derby entry does not replace a valid fishing licence.

LICENCE WILL BE CHECKED AT TIME OF ENTERING A FISH IN THE DERBY CONTEST

Derby applications will be accepted until 9:00 p.m. on February 8, 2013

EARLY BIRD draw will apply to participants entering on or before January 15, 2013.

The ONE DAY DERBY will take place Saturday, February 9, 2013

with fishing times 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.. All pike entries must be registered at the check-in station and turned in to the arena weigh-in station within one hour of final fishing time.

No Participant fishing or drilling holes allowed from February 4 until February 9, 2013 at 7:00 a.m.

Check-in time will start at 6:30 a.m.! **No drilling holes or fishing prior to 7:00 a.m.** Check out times will continue until one half hour after fishing time.

Entry fee <u>refunds</u> and <u>transfers</u> will be available until February 1, 2013 incurring a fee of \$20.00.

The derby committee reserves the right to cancel the derby at their discretion.

No cars or trucks allowed on the ice during the derby.

All participants will fish with a maximum of two lines and are not allowed to fish with non-participants.

Only one major prize will be awarded per entrant excluding early-bird draw.

All pike must be live, 24 inches or more and registered at the Civic Centre Check-in station by the participant catching the fish then brought to the Arena, 3 Maple Street, Chapleau for the official weighin.

A total of two (2) pike per entrant are allowed to be entered and each must be larger than the last because only the largest one qualifies for a prize.

The decisions of the Derby Committee re: weigh-ins, allowable entries, prizes etc. are final.

A minimum distance of 25 feet from other participants or groups is required, (exception being individual entrants in the same group). 200 feet distance is required from non-participants that are fishing.

All participants must affix their numbered flag sticks next to the holes in which they are fishing. If fishing in a hut, a flag must be affixed to the hut and inspections allowed.

All participants are required to return their flag sticks to the checkin station at the end of the derby. A prize will be drawn. Participants will be disqualified and may be prosecuted for using fraudulent means to win prizes. The Derby Committee reserves the right to investigate, question or disqualify any participant.

There is no minimum age for participants, however, all minors (under 18 years of age) must be accompanied by a legal guardian or parent at all times during the derby. All participants qualify for all prizes.

In the event of a weigh-in tie, the winner will be determined by the earliest time the fish was registered at the check-in station.

Boundaries are not to be moved once they have been established by the Derby Committee and participants must fish within the marked boundaries to qualify for prizes.

By entering the derby, all participants declare an understanding of the derby rules and agree to abide by them. All rules are subject to the interpretation of the Derby Executive Committee.

Entrants upon registration agree to indemnify and save harmless the Rotary Club of Chapleau Pike Ice Fishing Derby, their agents, employees, sponsors and event volunteers from any liability, expense, claims or demands that may arise from participating.

Prizes 1 to 5 are only available to those entering a qualifying Northern Pike.


