Title: Noise By-law Exemption for Wellington Street at St. David Street

Objective: To obtain an exemption to Noise By-law 113-79 to allow Wightman Telecom Ltd., working on behalf of Festival Hydro, to work on November 16, 2019 from 11:00 p.m. to November 17, 2019 12:00 p.m.

Background: Background: Wightman Telecom Ltd. has been retained by Festival Hydro to replace fibre optic connections on their fibre network at the corner of Wellington Street at St. David Street. In order to minimize the disruption to their customers, Festival Hydro would like to carry out the work from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. on November 16, 2019 from 11:00 p.m. to November 17, 2019 12:00 p.m. Noise By-law 113-79 prohibits the operation of any equipment in connection with construction in a residential zone from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Analysis: The noise exemption is for the generator that will be used to power the work trailer, 4 way flashing lights, and an arrow board (positioned at the back of the trailer for oncoming traffic). Wightman has indicated the generator generates noise at 60dB and will be enclosed in the trailer. This is equivalent to a residential air conditioner.

The location of the work is adjacent to single family homes. Past exemptions have been provided for similar work to Wightman in residential areas and the City has not received any complaints.

Financial Impact: There is no direct financial impact to the City of Stratford.

Staff Recommendation: **THAT an exemption from Noise Control By-law 113-79 be granted to Wightman Telecom Ltd. on November 16, 2019 from 11:00 p.m. to November 17, 2019 12:00 p.m.**

BY-LAW NUMBER -2019
OF
THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF STRATFORD

BEING a By-law to amend By-law 226-2005 as amended, to revise appointments of municipal law enforcement officers for The Corporation of the City of Stratford to enforce Snow and Ice Removal By-law 225-2005.

WHEREAS the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15* as amended, authorizes municipal councils to appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the *Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33*, as amended, provides for the designation by a Minister of the Crown of any person or class of persons as a Provincial Offences Officer for the purpose of all or any class of offences;

AND WHEREAS the Solicitor General (Ontario) has designated all employees of municipalities whose duties include the enforcement of municipal by-laws and persons appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers under the *Police Act* as Provincial Offences Officers;

AND WHEREAS Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford adopted Snow and Ice Removal By-law 225-2005 and considers it necessary to revise appointments of municipal law enforcement officers to reflect staffing changes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford as follows:

1. That the appointments of Jim Myers and David Dwyer as municipal law enforcement officers of The Corporation of the City of Stratford for the enforcement of Snow and Ice Removal By-law 225-2005, are hereby rescinded.
2. That Nick Sheldon is hereby appointed as a municipal law enforcement officer of The Corporation of the City of Stratford for the enforcement of Snow and Ice Removal By-law 225-2005.
3. That Schedule "A" of By-law 226-2005 as amended, is hereby repealed and replaced with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
4. This By-law comes into force and takes effect upon its passing.
