1. Call to Order

Co-Chair de Mel called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest

None

3. Approval of Minutes

4. Presentations/Discussion Items

4.1 Wind Reach Farms

Ms. Kelly Taylor, Volunteer Coordinator, delivered an informative presentation on Wind Reach Farms, a not-for-profit organization for people of all abilities to enjoy farming and recreation, located in Ashburn, ON. Ms. Taylor provided details of day visit, therapeutic riding program, accessible accommodations, work experience program and volunteer program opportunities with Wind Reach Farms. The farm receives over 20,000 visits each year.

Ms. Taylor distributed materials relative to upcoming events at the Farm, as well as orientation sessions for potential volunteers. She noted the availability of volunteer opportunities for tour leaders, animal care, stables assistance, gardening, special events, as well as administration and the general store.

An informational video was shown and Members posed questions relative to fundraising and donations. Chair de Mel thanked Ms. Taylor for taking the time to meet with the Committee and share information on volunteer opportunities.

4.2 June is Recreation & Parks Month

Ms. Wood introduced Ms. Ashley Galea, Recreation Supervisor, who presented information on the Town's plans to recognize June as Recreation and Parks Month. Details were provided relative to an online poll to select the 2014 theme, which will help shape the events and activities for the month.

Ms. Galea reviewed the 2013 activities and shared possible ideas for inclusion in 2014 which included program/fitness try-it opportunities, tie-in with the I CAN...Get Active Challenge, showcasing new preschool equipment, and recognition of National Skateboarding Day.

Members proposed several suggestions for consideration, including a geo-caching challenge, healthy eating workshops, elevating the profile of fitness stations along the trails system, de-stressing techniques, line dancing and community walking programs. The Committee encouraged staff to provide a variety of high and low impact activities for all demographics to participate in. The suggestion was made to use the promotional postcard as a pass to try a drop in class for free during the month of June.

Ms. Galea requested a volunteer from the Committee to participate in the June is Recreation and Parks Month Proclamation at the May 26, 2014 Council Meeting.

4.3 Advisory Committee Review

Ms. Moore solicited comments and feedback from the Committee relative to several new and revised advisory committee-related documents. Specific focus was paid to the Advisory Committee Policy & Procedure document and the Recreation & Culture Advisory Committee Profile.

It was recommended that the wording of the mandate reflect the Committee's desire to improve the quality of life in Ajax for residents and visitors. Members did not express concerns with possible future criminal reference check requirements. The Committee

proposed revising language in the policy and procedure document to reflect inclusivity rather than diversity. The broad scope and interests engaged by the committee were discussed.

Additional comments and feedback were requested by early April.

5. Standing Items

5.1 2013 Work Plan

Several updates on completed items were noted. Duplications were identified for revision. Members discussed continued interest in supporting the development of a Farmers Market in Pickering Village. Councillor Crawford reviewed some of the concerns identified and agreed to continue discussions with the Pickering Village BIA.

5.2 Recreation & Culture Departmental Update

Ms. Wood circulated promotional materials for several forthcoming community events and opportunities including Silver Screen Sundays, Dirty Dishes concert, Bomb Girls movie screening and the launch of a Town of Ajax Song Project. Members inquired why such a short time line is being provided for entry submission, as the quality and number of submissions entered may be limited. Ms. Wood agreed to take back the Committees concerns to staff.

Ms. Barrett exited the Meeting (7:35 p.m.)

5.3 Pan Am 2015 Local Host Committee

Ms. Pratt provided a summary of the recent Pan Am 2015 Local Host Committee meeting, at which a presentation was received from Durham Sport and members brainstormed volunteer opportunities for the Games. Ms. Pratt noted that Toronto 2015 will soon be releasing information about ticket packages that will go on sale in Fall 2014 an that the Toronto 2015 volunteer recruitment program will launch April 26, 2014.

6. Correspondence

Co-Chair de Mel informed the Committee he had received confirmation that the Committee's nomination for the 2013 Recreation Volunteer Recognition Award had been successful. He inquired whether any Member was interested in attending the ceremony on behalf of the Committee. Members expressed interest in a presentation on the Volunteer Recognition Program to gain insight on the structure and coordination of the program, eligibility details, etc.

7. Update from Council

Councillor Crawford shared information relative to several recent Council presentations including from Durham Region Police Services regarding Policing in Ajax, and from Durham

Clear, regarding Enbridge Pipe Line 9B. Details of a forthcoming Ward 1 & 2 Community Meeting were provided. Councillor interest in hosting a community meeting with Durham Region Police Services in the spring was noted.

8. New Business

8.1 Line dancing Demonstration

In the interest of time, this item was deferred to a future meeting.

8.1 Upcoming Events of Interest

Ms. Black provided details of an upcoming Spring Concert for the Pickering Community Concert Band. Chair de Mel discussed his forthcoming participation in the 220km Ride for Cancer in June 2014.
