Our Speakers > Steve Bauer



Steve Bauer CANADIAN CYCLING "LEGEND"

Steve Bauer brought recognition to Canada on the international cycling stage, and is regarded as one of the "legends" of Canadian cycling,. Bauer set a humble example of the way a small town Canadian hockey player can pave the way for future Canadian cyclists to achieve great things. In the spring of 1977 as a junior, Bauer joined the Canadian national track cycling team and raced in the Track World Cycling Championships in Vienna, Austria as a junior and also with the senior men's team in San Cristobal, Venezuela, The Canadian senior men's team of Lovell, Walton, Hayman and Bauer qualified in the team pursuit before being eliminated by East Germany. This would be a moment in Steve's life when he realized that

he should pursue a career in bike racing.

From 1981 to 1984 Steve road with GS Mangonie where founder Fred Mengonie mentored Steve and encouraged him to train like a pro. Fred set-up contact and training partnership with Greg Lemond. In the winter of 1983-84, Steve would log more endurance road miles then ever before. Steve transitioned to his professional career after winning a silver medal at 1984 Los Angeles Olympic Games Road Race. Following the games, Steve immediately transferred to Europe and after only one month as a pro, won bronze at the Professional Road World Championship in Barcelona, Spain. This moment was the beginning of a 12 year journey amongst cycling's greatest road athletes and historic competitions. As a first year pro in 1985 Steve rode the Tour de France with the La Vie Claire Team. Steve would lead the Tour wearing the white "rookie" jersey for almost the entire race before dropping behind the Columbian Fabio Parra. As a teammate of both Greg Lemond and Bernard Hinault, Steve would be the lieutenant for both mean as they battled for the Yellow Jersey and overall victory in both the 1985 and 1986 Tours. After changing team's to Weinmann – La Suisse in 1988, Bauer raced his personal best Tour de France,

FORMER CYCLING CHAMP

Giuseppi Marinoni is legendary in the Canadian bicycle world, known for the fine steel frames from his shop in Montreal that have borne his name over the past four decades. More recently, he made the news for setting a new hour record for his age group (75-plus), in the Fall of 2012. However, very few of us have actually had a chance to know the man himself. This has now been rectified with the recent release of the documentary Marinoni: The Fire in the Frame, at the HotDocs Festival in Toronto.

Giuseppe Marinoni spends most of his time making bikes, riding bikes and picking mushrooms. Former cycling champ turned iconic frame builder, Marinoni is the world hour

record holder for the over-75 age group on a classic bicycle. Now, at 78 years old, he still bikes 8000 km a year and is starting to think about challenging the hour record in Milton, Ontario when he turns 80.

Canada's Most Outstanding Cycling Olympic Team Coach And World Champion Honoured as one of Canada's most outstanding National Team Coaches, Olympic medalwinning coach Tanya Dubnicoff began as a World Class athlete herself. As a sprint cyclist, Tanya represented Canada at 3 Olympic games, won a World Championship title, and held the world record in her event. After Tanya's retirement as an athlete in 2000, her passion for the sport led her to coaching, where she felt she could share her knowledge and experience with upcoming athletes and give them everything they needed for success. Tanya spent the next 13 years building cycling programs in Canada and the United States.



Made in Canada with Master Bike Builder Marinoni



Made in Canada is a label not seen often enough in any industry, but particularly in the world of cycling. That is with the except of those few special road bikes marked with the renowned name of bike builder 'Marinoni'. The man behind this name is Giuseppi Marinoni, born in Bergamo, Italy in 1937 where he first learned to ride a bike, then graduated to racing them and eventually mastered the art of building them.

In 1965, while racing with the Italian National Team Marinoni came to Canada to compete in the Cours de Saint Laurent. The visit must have made an impression on this master bike builder because he decided to stay, much to the joy of future Canadian cyclists.

After hanging up his racing helmet in 1972 Marinoni returned to building some of the best road bikes. In 1974 he established Cycles Marinoni in Terrebonne Quebec alongside the gifted frame builder Marc Bouchard. The unique skill and talent behind these bike builders allowed them to amass a huge following including some of Canada's greatest cyclists: Gord Singleton, Jocelyn Lovell and Steve Bauer.

Having now entered his 70's Marinoni has handed down the responsibility of bike building to his son Paolo (and who can blame him?). But age hasn't stopped Marinoni from pursuing his passion for cycling, who on average cycles 300km per week. In fact in 2012, at the age of 75 years old, Marinoni broke the hour record in Brescia, Italy for the 74-79 year old age group by riding 35.728 km. It would seem that nothing can come between the famous Marinoni and his love for bikes.


