1. Call to Order

Chair Smith called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. With consent of those Members present, the Meeting proceeded without quorum.

2. Disclosure of Conflict of Interest

3. Approval of Minutes

4. Presentation/Discussion

4.1 Community Recreation & Parks Guide – Senior Supplement

Debbie Nickerson, Manager of Administration – Recreation & Culture, distributed copies of the latest edition of the Town of Ajax Community Recreation & Parks Guide. She noted that each issue, approximately 30,000 guide are distributed through Metroland to the community. Many municipalities are now transitioning to online program catalogues. D. Nickerson informed Members that a survey was conducted relative to the format of the guide and 150 responses were received. Most of the responses received came from the older adult population and identified a preference for the hard copy format.

- D. Nickerson advised that the Recreation and Culture Department will be implementing new software over the coming year that may affect the way programs and the guide are created. She noted that the Town will be maintaining the paper guide for at least another year. Over the past few years a 65% reduction in print costs for the guide was noted. She introduced the idea to create a standalone seniors supplement booklet, which would serve the older adult population if and when the guide transitions to online format.
- D. Nickerson reviewed pages 38-39 of the guide, noting that all of the seniors' events, financial assistance and club information has been consolidated into one section, for ease of use.

Members present provided comments relative to the Guide noting it is a hard copy staple in most households and was pleased the Town had surveyed the community to gauge its needs. They were in support of the seniors' supplement, but had mixed reviews about eliminating the paper guide all together. Questions were posed relative to whether those municipalities who have adopted online catalogues in place of paper copies have received fewer registrations. D. Nickerson noted that was not the case.

J. Wood noted that the Work Plan had been included in the agenda package. She encouraged Members to provide input and suggestions for items they would like to see come forward in the New Year.

7.2 Recreation & Culture Departmental Update

- J. Wood provided several upcoming event updates including sharing information about the St. Francis Centre Duffle Bag Theatre performances of A Christmas Carol, which take place on the same day as the Pickering Village Christmas in the Village event (Saturday December 12, 2015). Information on the January 8, 2016 screening of Trumbo was also shared.
- J. Wood informed the Committee that in light of recent criminal charges against its owner, the Ajax Swim Club has folded. She shared information on a partnership with the Oshawa Aquatics Club and several of the assistant coaches from the former Ajax Swim Club to commence in the New Year. Swimmers will be allowed to continue swimming in Ajax and competing under the umbrella of the Oshawa Aquatics Club, until the assistant coaches process their certification from Swim Ontario, to open a new Ajax club.

- R. Tyler Morin invited Members to attend a musical event at the Ajax Downs on December 10, 2015, at which he and his band would be playing.
