
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To consult with local not-for-profits and community service providers serving Ajax residents through surveys and facilitated conversations on how to better collaborate and improve the Town's community development service.



Expand on youth career programming and services.






## **Objectives:**

- Develop a resource for Ajax Young Adults to access skills, knowledge and experience to become more employable or an entrepreneur.
- Develop connections for Ajax Young Adults to gain mentors and network with local business leaders.





## Inputs:

- Ajax Staff time (Project lead)
- Partner resources (15 partners participated)
- Presenters' Expertise (30 presenters)
- Business Leaders' mentoring (30+ in person meetings)
- Meeting Space (Ajax Business Centre)
- Funding (\$30,000)





## **Outputs:**

#### Initial Goals:

- 20-25 applicants
- 20-50 businesses
- 1-3 employed
- 1-3 start business

### **Program Overview:**

- 75 hours of connections and experience
- 35 group training sessions
- 15 days of programming
- 15 partner organizations

#### Actuals:

- 100+ applicants 55 Confirmed for group interview
- 28 participants started program
- 24 completed the program
- 100+ businesses registered
- 70 businesses confirmed participation
- 2 started business
- 4 employed
- 1 offered a volunteer Board of Directors position
