



#### 1. Call to Order

Co-Chair Middleton called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

#### 4. Presentations/Discussion Items

#### 4.1 Wind Reach Farms

Ms. Kelly Taylor, Volunteer Coordinator, delivered an informative presentation on Wind Reach Farms, a not-for-profit organization for people of all abilities to enjoy farming and recreation, located in Ashburn, ON. Ms. Taylor provided details of day visit, therapeutic riding program, accessible accommodations, work experience program and volunteer program opportunities with Wind Reach Farms. The farm receives over 20,000 visits each year.

Ms. Taylor distributed materials relative to upcoming events at the Farm, as well as orientation sessions for potential volunteers. She noted the availability of volunteer opportunities for tour leaders, animal care, stables assistance, gardening, special events, as well as administration and the general store. She spoke about recent funding received for future creation of a 'sensory trail', which will incorporate elements to stimulate all of the senses.

An informational video was shown and Members posed questions relative to sponsorship and volunteer eligibility. Chair Middleton thanked Ms. Taylor for taking the time to meet with the Committee and share information on volunteer opportunities.

#### 4.2 Advisory Committee Review

Ms. Moore solicited comments and feedback from the Committee relative to several new and revised advisory committee-related documents. Specific focus was paid to the Advisory Committee Policy & Procedure document and the Active Transportation & Trails Advisory Committee Profile.

It was recommended that the wording of the Committee's purpose also include wording relative to the benefits of healthily active living. Members proposed including reference to the Durham Trail Coordinating Committee and Pumpkinville event participation. The broad scope and interests engaged by the committee were discussed. Link to the Town's Integrated Community Sustainability Plan document was identified.

Additional comments and feedback were requested by April 4, 2014.

#### 4.3 2013 Monthly Walk Review and 2014 Walk Schedule

Co-Chair. Middleton circulated copies of the final 2014 Monthly Walk Schedule. It was requested that a copy be posted on the Town's website, and include the day and duration of the walk. Communications for the 2014 walk schedule were discussed in detail. Members were reminded that details of each walk could be self-populated through the Town's website It was noted that the schedule circulated will be printed on promotional magnets, which should be available for distribution in time for the June 22, 2014 Trailfest event. Mr. Cooke agreed to coordinate a working group to meet and prepare the trail descriptions and maps for Ms. Warsh to post online. Materials will be provided to staff by April 11, 2014.
