Be SHORT & SPECIFIC – It SHOULD NOT be Detail Oriented e.g. "We should create an Essex Arts and Culture Award"

- 2. All ideas are good ideas
- 3. Be prepared to check (require some clarification) and endorse (defend/define/promote)
- 4. Priorities will be assigned to interested committee members and objectives will be defined later lets develop the idea before we develop the end result!
