1. Call to Order

Acting-Chair Smith called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. Members were welcomed and roundtable introductions were made.

4. Presentation/Discussion

4.1 Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act & AAC Overview

Shandell Conboy entered the meeting (6:20 p.m.)

S. Moore delivered a detailed presentation relative to the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 and the role of municipal accessibility advisory committees. She spoke about the various pieces of provincial legislation influencing accessibility including the

Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), 2005, Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 200, Ontario Planning Act, Ontario Building Code, Ontario Human Rights Code and The Blind Person's Rights Act, including related requirements.

The requirement for establishing a municipal accessibility advisory committee was identified through the AODA. S. Moore reviewed the Committee's mandate and explained that the committee is responsible for providing advice on a wide range of municipal processes including reviewing site plans, participating in consultations, reviewing official plans, providing accessible places and methods to vote, and monitoring compliance with accessibility requirements. The roles of advocacy and advisory were discussed and clarified.

Several Members shared anecdotes of how far accessibility awareness has come through recent years. Members discussed the Province's shift in focus on audits of private sector provincial accessibility compliance to more awareness communication. Limitations on compliance for the private sector were noted. S. Moore distributed copies of the "Making Accessible Happen" guide to serving on a municipal accessibility advisory committee and encouraged Members to review and retain as a resource tool.

4.2 2014 Volunteer Recognition Award Submission

S. Moore thanked the Committee for their review of the Town of Ajax Accessibility Award Nomination for Ajax Home Depot. Members committed to reviewing award nomination opportunities through the Town and Region of Durham well in advance throughout the year in order to prepare submissions.

4.3 National Access Awareness Week/AODA 10th Anniversary Recognition

S. Moore provided an overview of National Access Awareness Week and noted that the 10th anniversary of the AODA will be recognized on June 13, 2015. She solicited feedback from the Committee on ideas for potential recognition activities. A summary of past recognition events was shared for the information of new Members.

Members shared suggestions relative to connecting with the Ajax Public Library to build on 2014 events. A Parapan/recreation theme was proposed. S. Moore reminded the Committee of their contact with Paralympian and future Parapan tennis athlete Joel Dembe, as a possible participant in recognition events. The Committee was asked to brainstorm activities in order for more fulsome discussion at the April Meeting.

S. Moore agreed to circulate the dates for recognition via email once confirmed.

4.4 April 1, 2015 Ajax Business Network Invitation

S. Moore noted that staff from the Economic Development Section had extended an invitation to the Committee to set up an information booth/display at its April 1, 2015 Ajax Business Network Event, which is focused on preparing local businesses for the Pan Am Games. S. Moore informed the Committee of the opportunity to develop a Pan Am-specific communications piece for businesses and committed to sending draft materials for the Committee's review and input via email. Several Members expressed interest in attending. Further details will be circulated by email in regards to timing and registration to attend the

event. Members asked S. Moore to request a few minutes to speak at the beginning of the session.
