Plus, as if "FREE" isn't exciting enough, most of our locations will be hosting specially themed tours, demonstrations, exhibits, and meals for this fun filled day.

The 2014 Doors Open festival is designed for you to explore our rich town in new and exciting ways; let yourself become immersed in the history, art, and culture that have been shaping the character of Grimsby for decades.

## Where is it?

Grimsby, Ontario: a small town nestled between Lake Ontario and the Niagara Escarpment. Grimsby is described as the "Gateway to Niagara" as it is a 15 minute drive from Hamilton and St. Catharines, 30 minutes from Niagara Falls and approximately an hour from Toronto. Established in 1790, the town is recognized as the birthplace of local government in Ontario. A major early industry which continues to this day is fruit farming, with such produce as peaches, grapes, cherries, apples and pears, resulting from the unique local conditions and climate. Grimsby is known as the beginning of the Wine Route with a number of quality wineries located in the vicinity.
