4. Presentation/Discussion

4.1 Bike Month 2016

E. Leung and Chair Black led discussion relative to Bike Month 2016 events and initiatives. Chair Black reviewed proposed details for a family bike ride on Sunday June 19, 2016 that could be promoted at Trailfest. The suggested route will start at Nottingham School, stop at the McLean Community Centre then head along Deleany, through Pickering Village to the Village Ice Cream Shop for a break before heading back. Members inquired the timing for the event, distance and whether washrooms would be available. Chair Black informed Members that the ride would start at 1 p.m. and be approximately 5 km. A rain date for the ride was noted as June 26, 2016.

Volunteers were sought to assist with the Trailfest information booth and bike ride. C. Antram and K. Haines volunteered to attend Trailfest for the booth. K. Haines and W. Hingston volunteered to assist Chair Black with the family ride on June 19, 2016. Members proposed setting up an online sign-up and providing swag to ride participants. It was suggested that the schools taking part in Bike to School Week be contacted and invited to participate in the family ride.

Those Members assisting with the Trailfest ride/sweep requested a t-shirt or high-vis. vest from Operations to wear at the event and increase visibility. Promotion of Trailfest was also encouraged to include distance references to the ride lengths (ex. That's like riding from here to Oshawa!), so that participants had greater understanding of the level of difficulty and their skill set.

5. Correspondence

W. Hingston shared an email from Bruce MacDonald, Chair of the Whitby Active Transportation Committee and member of the Durham Region Cycling Coalition expressing interest in appearing as a delegation at the June 16, 2016 Meeting.

W. Hingston shared a recent letter to the editor from the Ajax News Advertiser relative to roundabout concerns.

6. Update from Council

Councillor Crawford provided an update on the Duffins Creek Water Pollution Control Plant matter. She informed the Committee that the Minister of Environment has ordered the Regions of York and Durham to prepare a Phosphorus Reduction Action Plan (PRAP) over the next nine months for the Duffins Creek Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). She provided a review of <u>Dr. Auer's recent presentation to the General Government Committee</u>. She also noted that information on forthcoming PACT-POW events will be forwarded to the Committee for interest once detail s are confirmed.

7. Standing Items

7.1 Work Plan

Members expressed that a follow-up to Bike Month activities be added to the September agenda. Interest in presentations on the Zip car program, e-vehicles and self-driving cars were expressed.

Members inquired what happens to DRT bus stops and infrastructure after stops are moved. C. Antram noted that it remains for 6 months and then is removed based on a schedule set up between DRT and Regional Works.. S. Logan inquired about follow-up to his curb cut requests from fall 2015. E. Leung agreed to report back.

D. Ramkallie exited the Meeting. (7:20 p.m.)

8. New Business

Lakeview Boulevard Community Working Group Update

W. Hingston noted that he had attended the first meeting of the Community Working Group and that several Public Information Centres will be held over the coming months. He encouraged Members to attend and agreed to forward details by email.

Members shared concern for the traffic calming installation along Clements Road West. They encouraged staff to relocate no parking signage further back from the calming elements, as on-street parking is creating a bottle-neck situation.
