4. Presentation/Discussion

4.1 Volunteer Recognition Awards

Laura Tegelberg, Community Development Coordinator, provided an overview of the annual Volunteer Recognition Awards event, which recognizes volunteer contributions in Ajax over the previous calendar year. She solicited two volunteers from the Committee to participate in the Award Selection Committee. This year's theme is "Creating ripples of change". The Volunteer Recognition Awards night will coincide with National Volunteer Week, and be held on April 12, 2016. L. Tegelberg distributed nomination forms and noted the deadline for submissions to be March 7, 2016. She reviewed the award categories and noted that new this year, the Ajax Civic Award recipients will be determined by the Award Selection Committee. The selection committee will be comprised of 1-2 representatives from each advisory committee and three past civic award recipients (2 adult and 1 youth). The nomination form will also be made available online as well at www.ajax.ca/volunteer. The Award Selection Committee will be meeting on March 21 at 6 p.m. K. Haines and L. Trauzzi volunteered to take part.

4.2 2016 Capital Projects

Carol Coleman, Manager of Engineering – Capital Projects, provided a detailed overview of projects to be undertaken in 2016 in the areas of roads, bridges, parks, trails and sidewalks. Projects discussed included:

- Road Construction
 - o Rossland Road Phases 1 & 2
 - Brock Road
 - Riverside Drive
 - Westney Road
- Harwood Cycling Facilities and Parking Improvements
 - New traffic signals (Salem Road and Lord Road and Harwood Avenue and Hibbard)
- Environmental Assessments
 - Hunt Street & Finley Avenue
 - Ajax Downtown Road Network
 - Lakeview Boulevard Improvements
- Sidewalk and Trail Construction
 - Finley Avenue
 - Carruthers Trail
 - Rotary Park Trail
 - Harwood Trail
 - Salem Trail

A detailed hard copy of C. Coleman's presentation was provided to all Members.

4.3 Healthy Kids Community Challenge

Kevin Smith, Active Living Coordinator, provided an update on programming to be implemented through the first phase of funding from the Healthy Kids Community Challenge grant. He shared an overview of ice skate, cycling and snowshoe loans, as well as plans to implement bike racks at local schools and discuss cycling safety and walking initiatives. Events including sidewalk chalking and sport ball giveaways were also noted. He informed

the Committee that workshops on cycling safety will be held in the coming weeks with teachers and parent champions to help promote active and safe routes to schools.

K. Smith reviewed the marketing strategy for the Challenge, which included creation of a website, active pop-up zones at Town and community events as well as the 2,016 kids pledge to take the challenge. Other initiatives in support of the Run, Jump, Play, Everyday theme will include neighbourhoods BBQs and play days, healthy active living heroes, and a storybook trail, in partnership with the Ajax Public Library. A summary of the media launch was shared. The second phase will have a nutrition (water as a healthy alternative) theme that will commence in July 2016. He encouraged Members to visit the new website: www.healthykidsajax.ca for more information. Within the first week of the campaign, 176 people have taken the pledge and the survey has been completed by over 100 families.

Members shared positive feedback on the program activities, especially the equipment loans, and infographic. It was encouraged that the Town work with local school boards to promote availability of skate rentals for their class trips. Questions were posed relative to the use of drop-in sports and demographics.

4.3 Bike Month Activity Brainstorming

Chair Black facilitated a brainstorming session and discussion on potential Bike Month activities the Committee could coordinate. Suggestions included:

- Participation in Trailfest (Mayor's Ride, Tour d'Ajax)
- Bike maintenance/clinics
- Engaging DRPS cycling police
- Community rides through different neighbourhoods in Ajax
- Proclamation to Council
- Competitions between local elementary schools to earn points for children who ride to school

Chair Black agreed to prepare draft outlines of correspondence that could be presented to the school board liaisons who sit on the Healthy Kids Community Challenge Steering Committee, in regards to the competition idea between schools. Members discussed potential prizes for the challenge, including a bicycle, helmets, and bells. C. Antram proposed that for Trailfest, a Durham Transit Bus be invited to take part, so that participants could learn how to load and unload their bicycles from the front bus carrier.

Members briefly discussed the process for using Zipcars and the addition of Zipcars to the Ajax GO Station.


The Committee expressed interest in learning more about electric vehicles at a forthcoming meeting.
