The Harrow Holy Spirit Festival has been one of the longest festivals celebrated by a community in Southern Ontario. There are similar festivals held in Windsor, Leamington, Chatham, Strathroy, London and Toronto. It was started over 30 years ago by a group of immigrants who wanted to share a beautiful story of their faith and culture. The theme is sharing the gifts of the Holy Spirit throughout our community. This festival has made our community a pillar of tradition throughout Ontario.

There are 3 important dates, a fundraiser in March and the actual Festival which takes place the first weekend of July. Hundreds of people participate in the festivities. On the final day of the festival, a HOST is picked to oversee the following Festival in the new year. On July 4th, my husband Nelson Pimentel was chosen as the "Mordomo" (host), which is a great honour and undertaking.

The "Holy Spirit Fundraiser" will be held on March 10th, 2018.
