#### 1. Call to Order

Chair Smith called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

#### 4. Presentation/Discussion Items

#### 4.1 2014 Customer Polling Results Summary

David Forget, Manager, Quality Service & Special Projects, delivered a presentation highlighting some of the key findings of the customer polling conducted in April 2014. He

noted that Ajax residents are generally satisfied with their government and Town staff; however there is an increased perception of barriers to accessing programs and services. Mr. Forget confirmed that the sample group was statistically considered to be a representative sample, comprised of 600 respondents balanced throughout all four wards.

Members agreed with local employment as a top issue of concern. Increased awareness for accessibility was also noted as a positive observation. Members discussed concerns with accessibility barriers at local schools concerning "kiss & ride" areas. Mr. Forget encouraged the committee to identify ways of reaching out to persons with disabilities to learn more about the increased perception that barriers to Town programs and services exists. The complete report of results was noted to be available on the Town's website.

On behalf of the Committee Ms. Dowd's presented Ms. Moore with flowers and thanked her for her support of the Committee.

#### 4.2 Spinal Cord injury

Ms. Millings delivered an informative presentation relative to spinal cord injury and her personal story. She provided a brief overview of the different between spinal column and spinal cord injury and the regions of the spine. Potential causes for injury, traumatic and non-traumatic injury, and effects of injury were reviewed. Ms. Mullings identified hidden aspects of spinal cord injury and shared information on the various assistive devices she regularly uses.

Ms. Mullings noted the intent of her presentation was to encourage sharing and learning amongst Committee Members. The Committee thanked Ms. Mullings for taking the initiative to share her story and educate others. Members briefly discussed suggestions for future educational presentations. Mr. Smith expressed interest in speaking about CNIB Night Walks in September.

#### 4.3 National Access Awareness Week Recognition Re-cap

The Committee de-briefed its 2014 accessibility awareness night at the Ajax Public Library and film screening events. Suggestions to host the event again in a larger space were shared. Overall the events were noted to be successful and well attended. Members expressed interest in setting up information booths at other events/times throughout the year outside of National Access Awareness Week.

#### 4.4 Recreation Training Check-in

Those Members participating in delivery of the Summer Recreation & Culture staff training on Monday June 23, 2014 noted they would be running through the presentation following the meeting for anyone interested in providing feedback.

#### 4.5 People in Motion Visit Re-cap

Ms. Dowd's, Ms. Mullings and Chair Smith provided an overview of their attendance at the 2014 People in Motion Show in Toronto. Numerous resources were shared and circulated. Some of which were proposed to be added to the website resource listing. Chair Smith noted that she had contacted GO Transit to commend the customer service ambassador providing assistance on their train for his exceptional customer service.

#### 4.6 Previous Business Update

Ms. Moore provided several updates relative to outstanding items and inquiries such as parking concerns, property complaints and the in case of emergency pocket discussion.

#### 4.7 Tentative Next Meeting Dates

The Committee decided the remaining meeting dates for the term to be September 10, 2014 and November 19, 2014.

#### 5. Standing Items

#### 5.1 Work Plan – New Term Vision

Members discussed interest in carrying over the education and awareness initiatives started this term. Interest was expressed in summer projects for members to conduct site audits of plazas and facilities to provide accessibility suggestions for consideration.

Additionally, Members expressed interest in reviewing property concerns and providing feedback to property owners relative to accessibility complaints received by the Town.
